The minutes for March 25th, 2014

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 PM by Club President, Jerry Bishop, W8KQ, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

- Glenn gave the treasurer's report and indicated that there was no change from the previous one.

Glenn mentioned that the Bay City Club did not have problems with interference when using multiple antennas. He was going to attempt to contact them to see how they had their filters set up.
